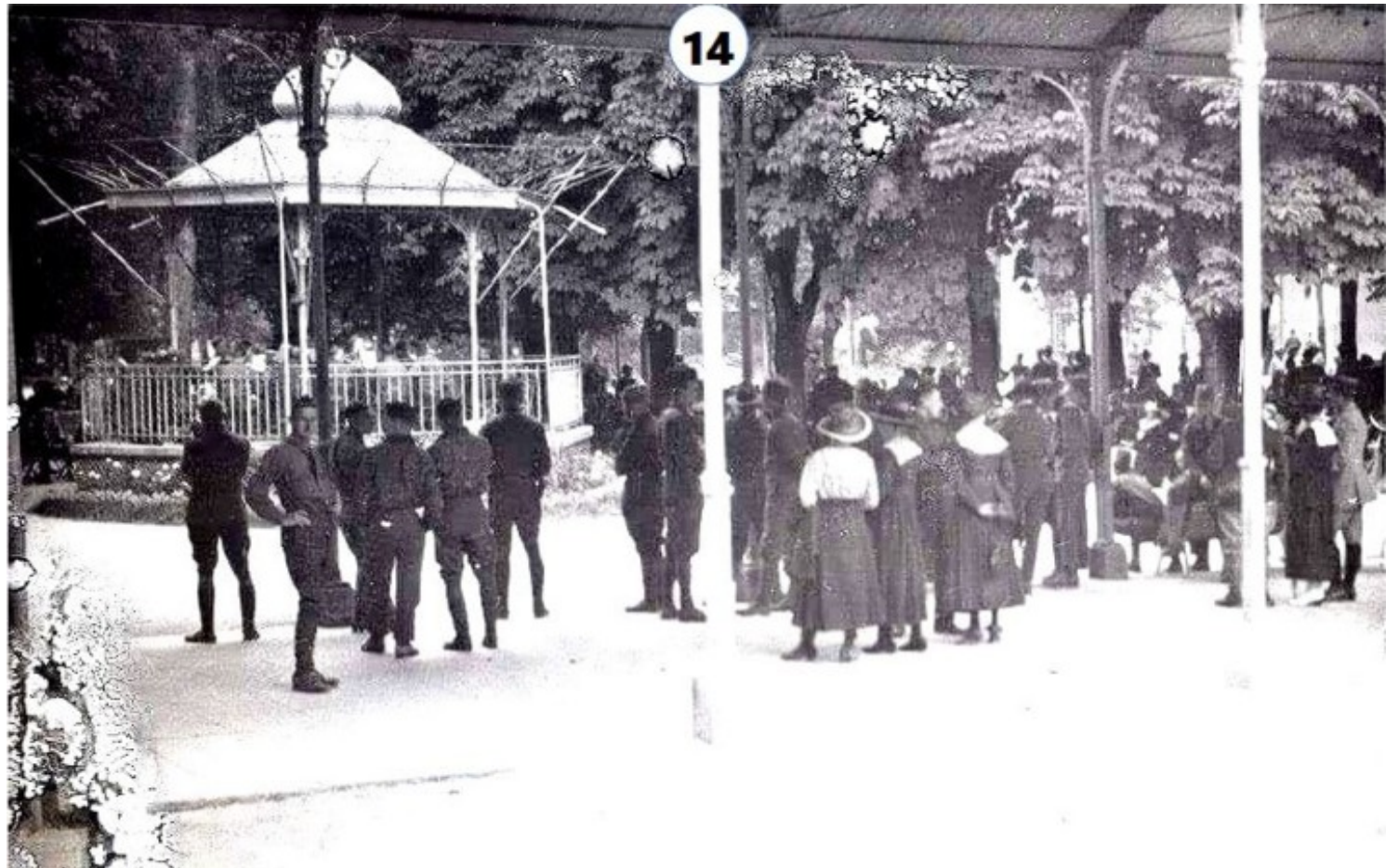
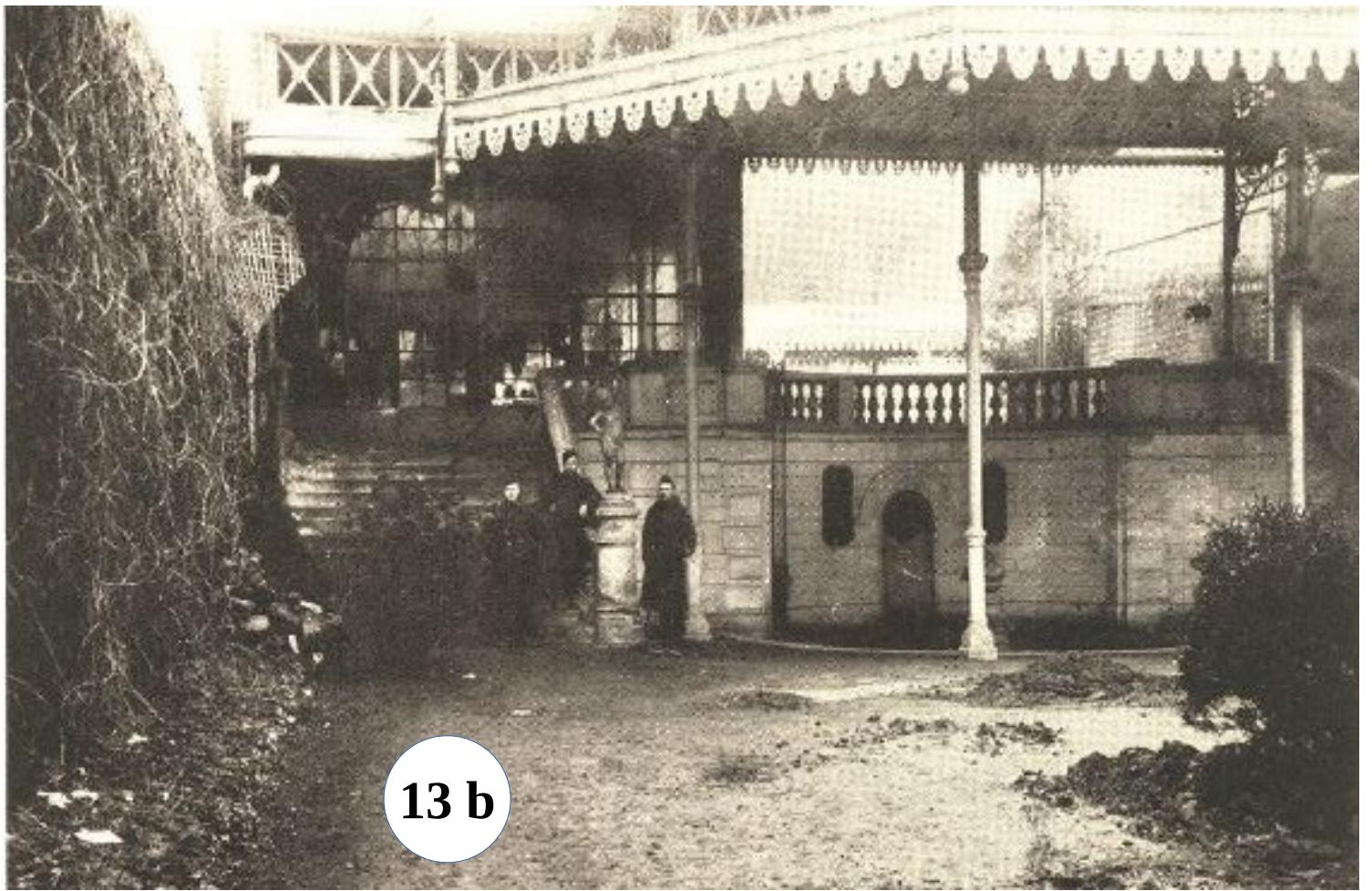
PART OF A FRENCH DIVISION PASSING THROUGH CONTREXEVILLE

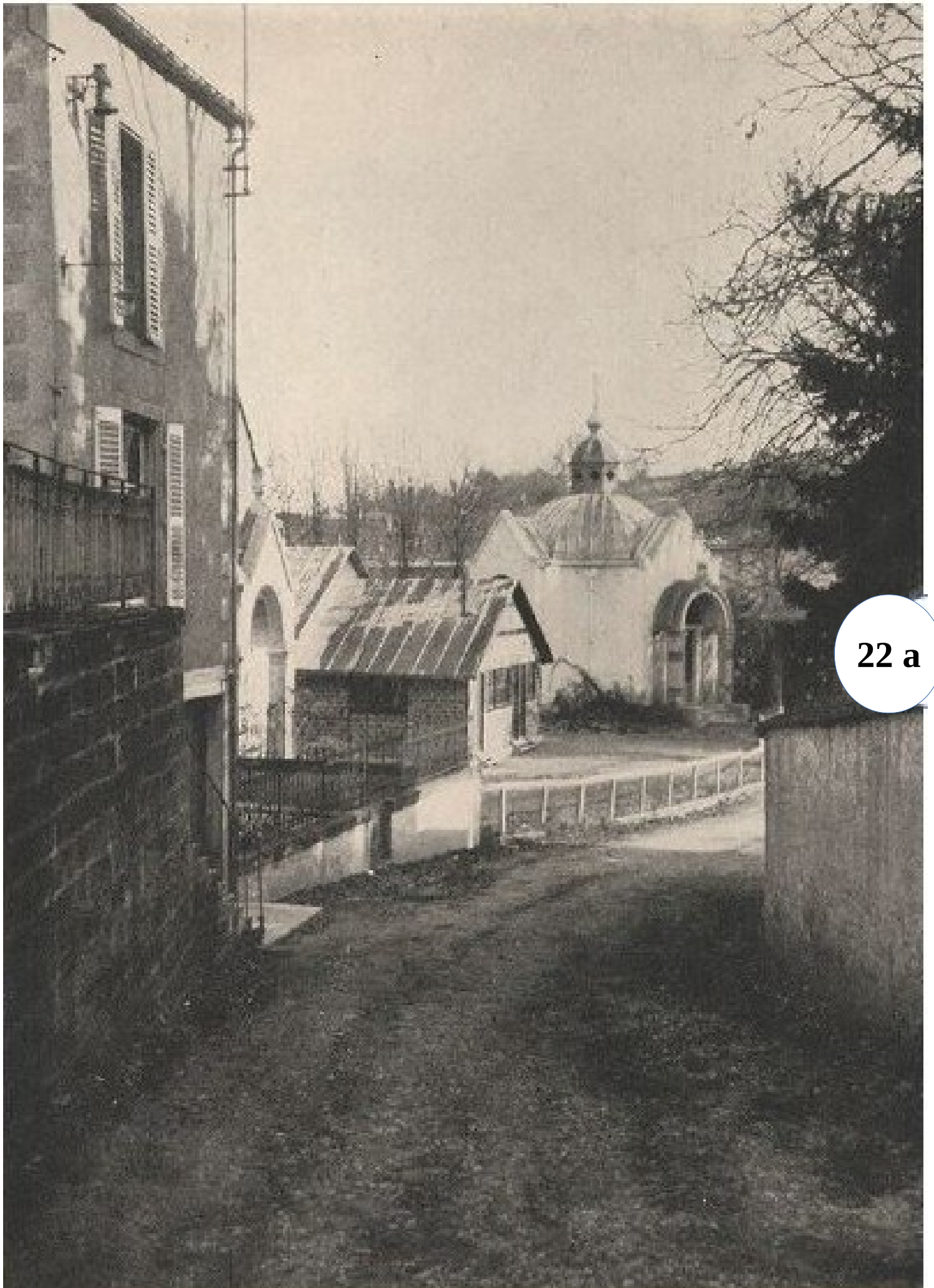

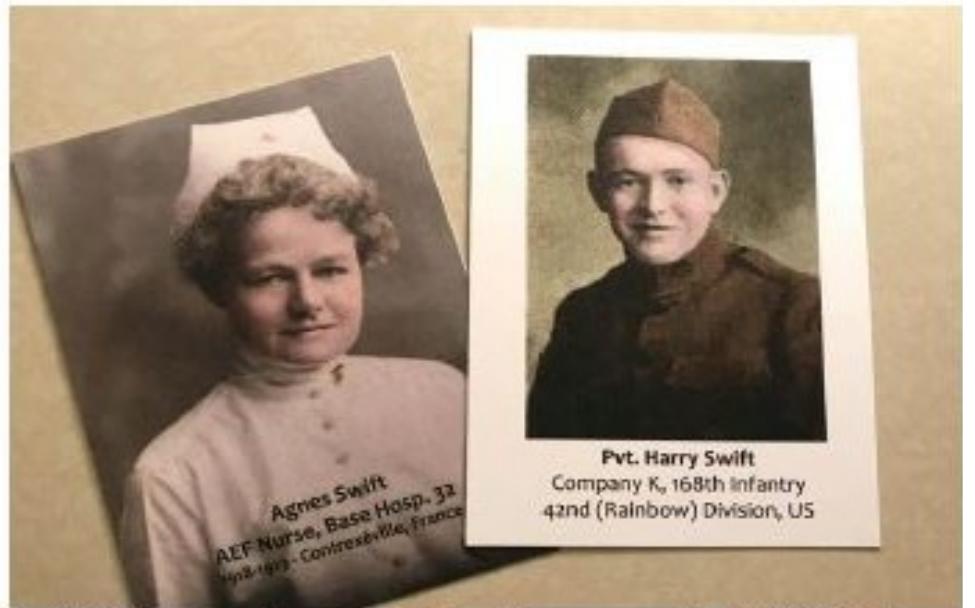
